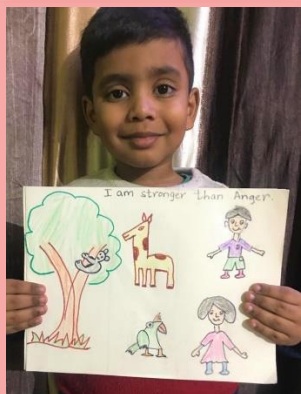
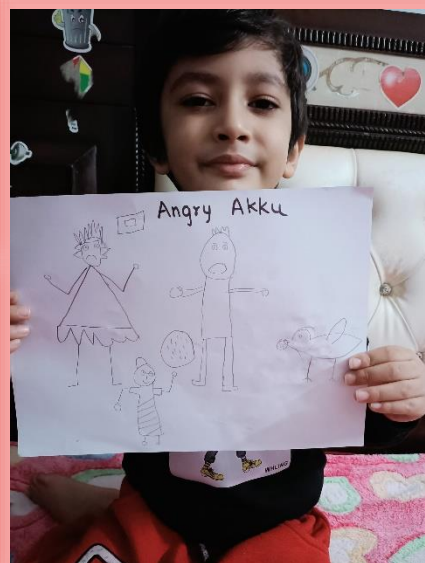
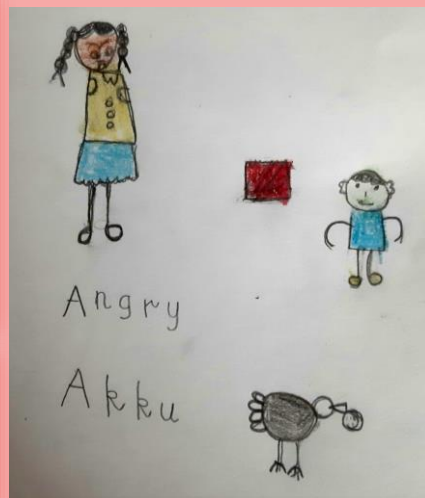
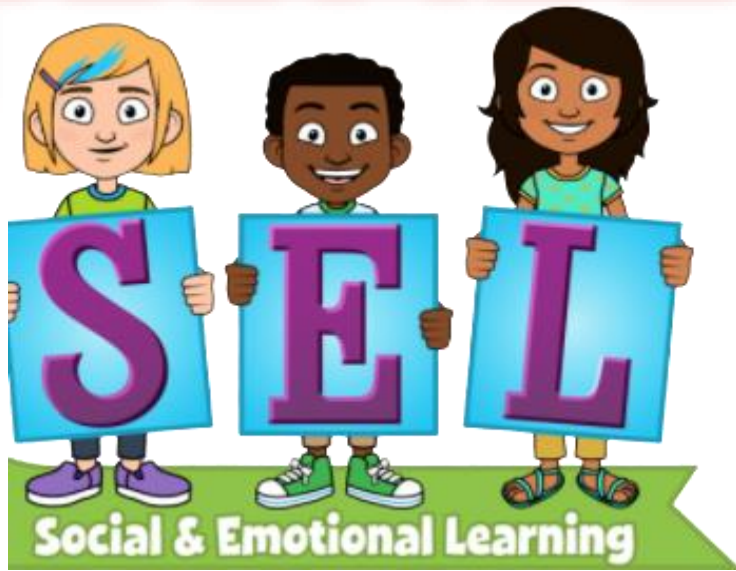


**CHALLENGE**



Design thinking is a way to define and solve tough challenges. As part of this curriculum the students were first shown the story of Ginger breadman. In the original story a fox offers help to the Gingerbread man to cross the river and he was finally gobbled up by the fox. But here we wanted the students to analyze the problem and come out with solutions to help the main character of the story cross the river. Students were able to weave brilliant ideas through guided approach and designed, boat, yacht, raft etc. with the available resources at home.





*SEL is a method of promoting holistic development by teaching students to regulate their emotions, such as anger, empathy, persistence, self-awareness etc. As part of this month's curriculum students were shown two stories "Angry Akku" and "I am stronger than anger". Students not only enjoyed these stories but they also learnt a few tips on how to calm themselves next time they get annoyed. During SEL connect they also informed their teachers about the tips they are going to follow for emotion management.*

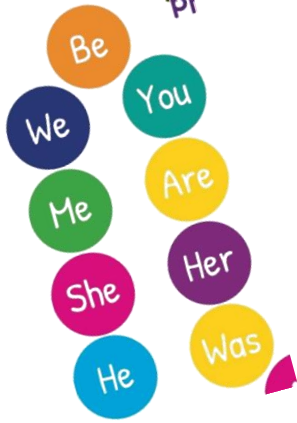
