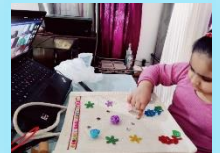
- **Khushboo Sao of Grade XI won the Gold and Bronze in Delhi State Badminton Championship 2021 under 17year girls category in doubles championship.**

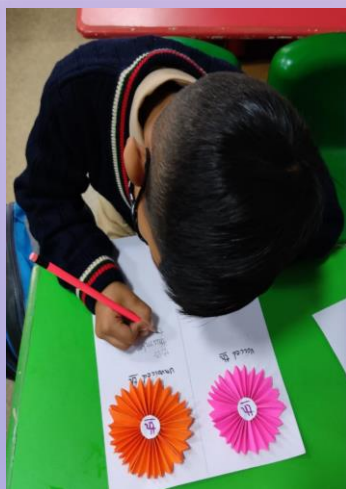
NEW JOYS

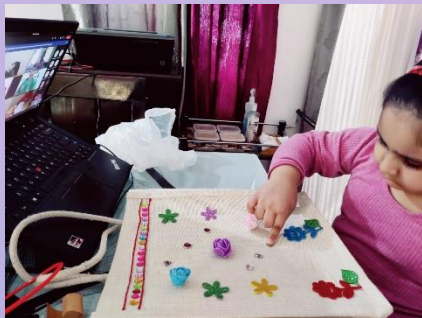

The students learnt the benefits of using jute and cloth bags as compared to plastic bags.



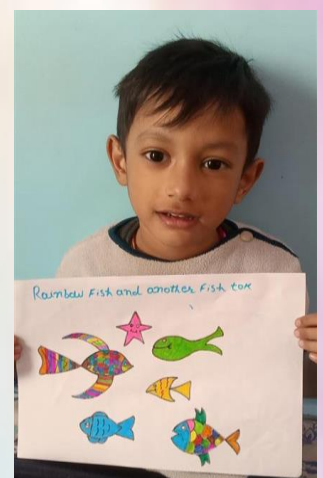
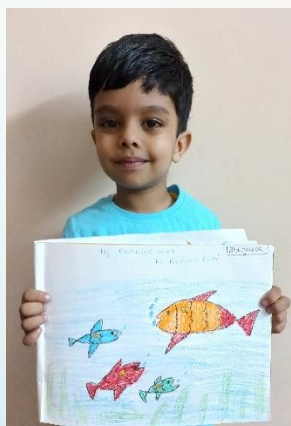
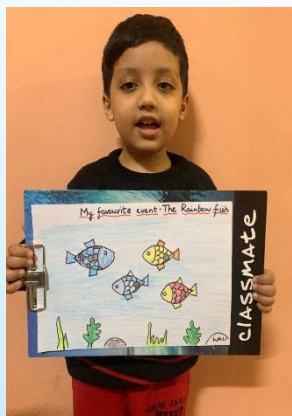

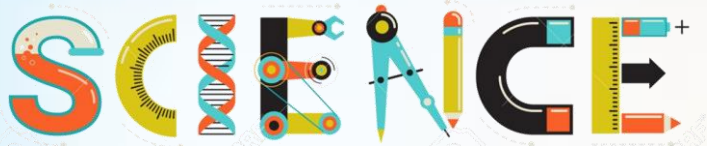
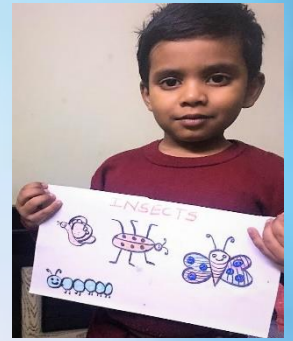


Bird feeder made out of disposable bowl



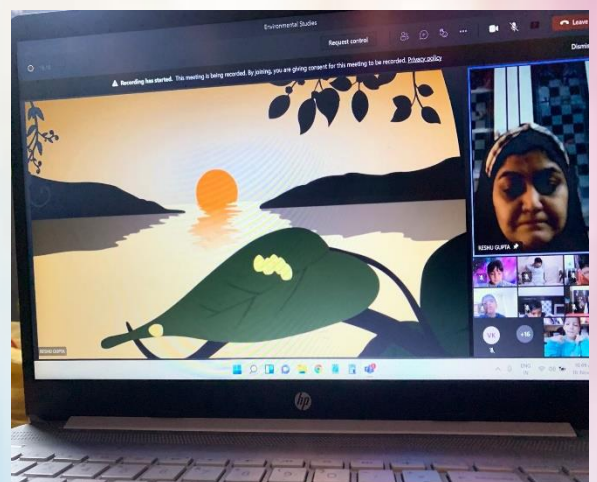
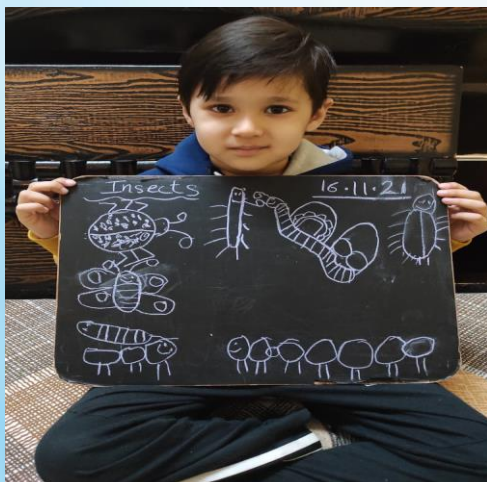

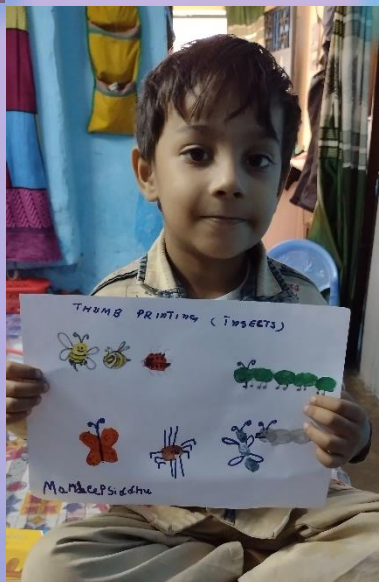
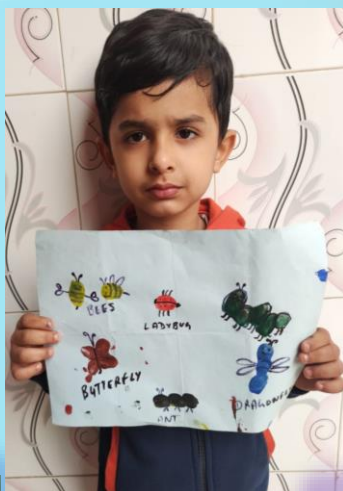
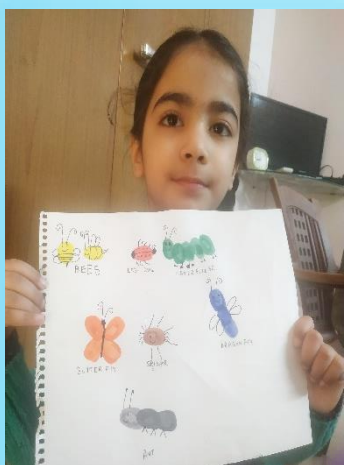


Through a ppt and a YouTube story students learnt the difference between living and non-living things and learnt the characteristics of both.



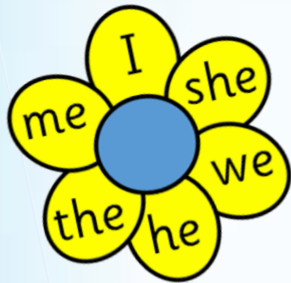


Insects – Students made different types of insects through thumb printing.

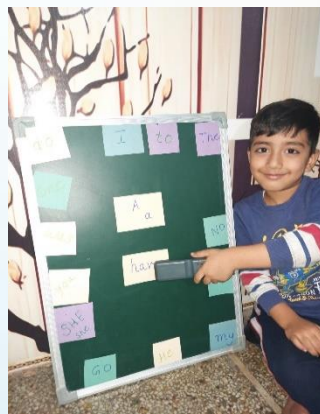

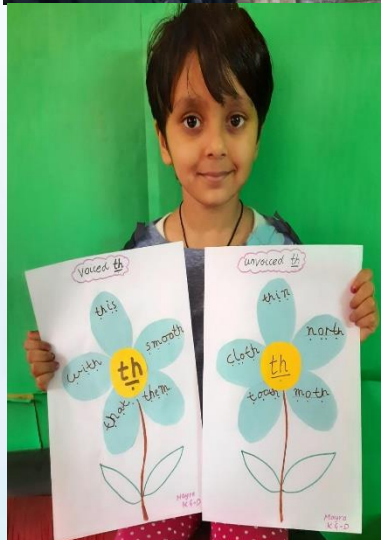
