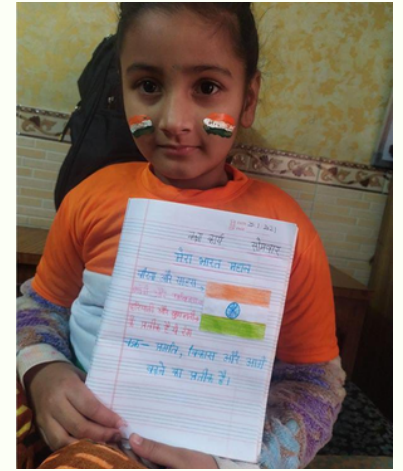
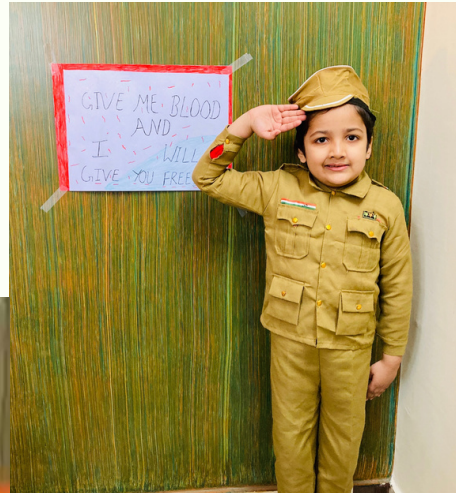
- *ASN Celebrated 72nd Republic Day.*

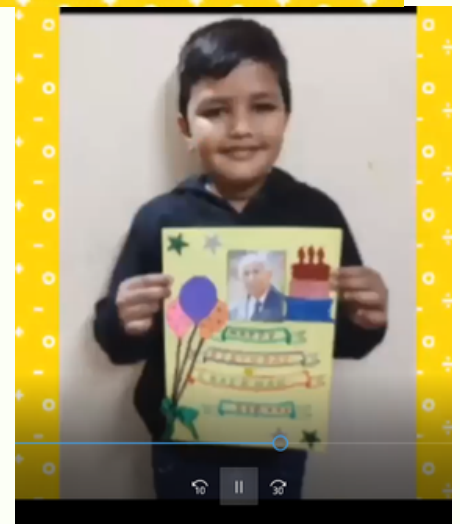
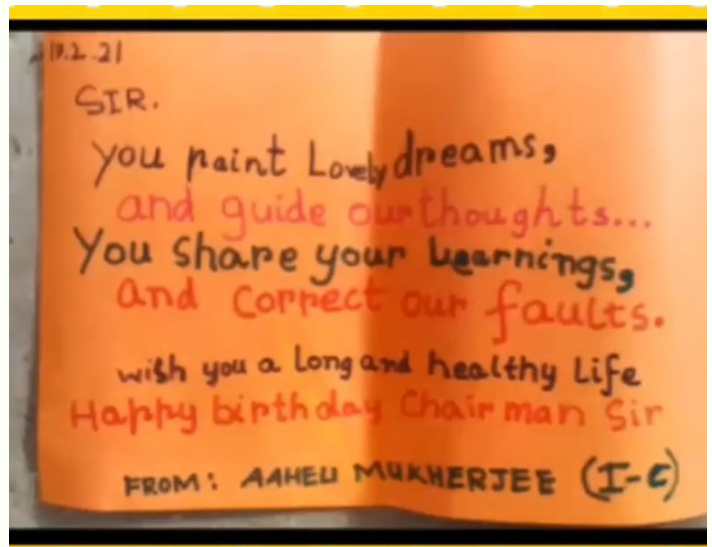
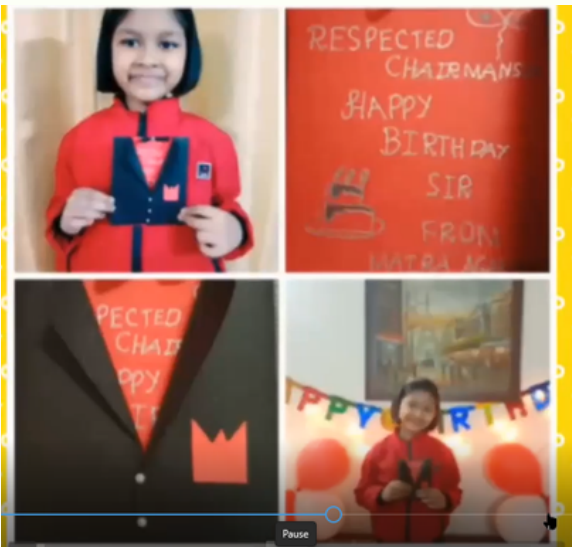
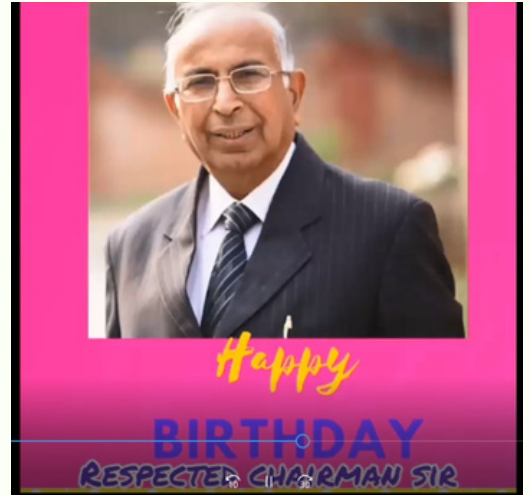
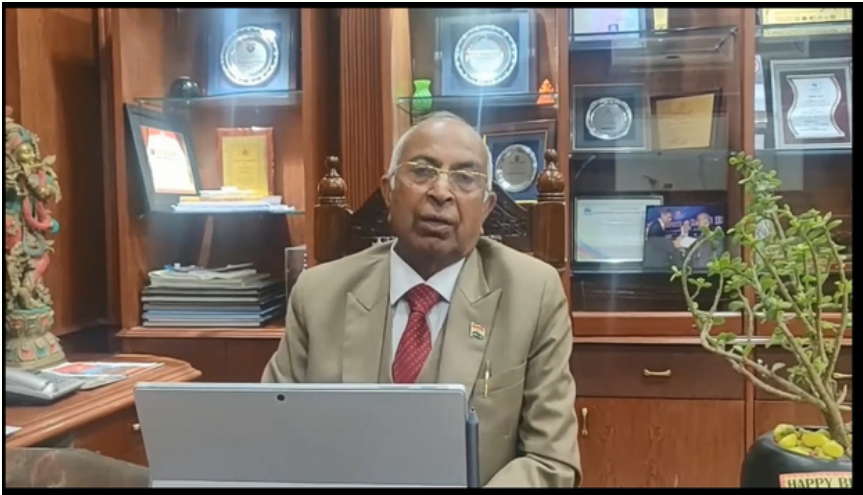
## REPUBLIC DAY

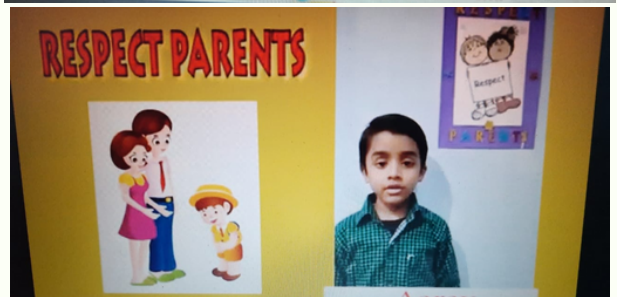
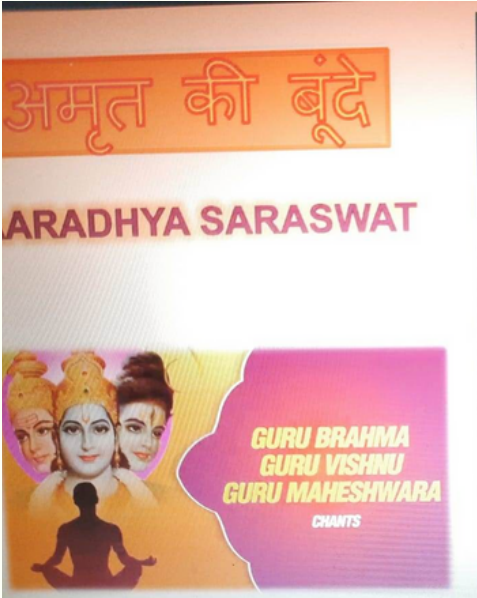
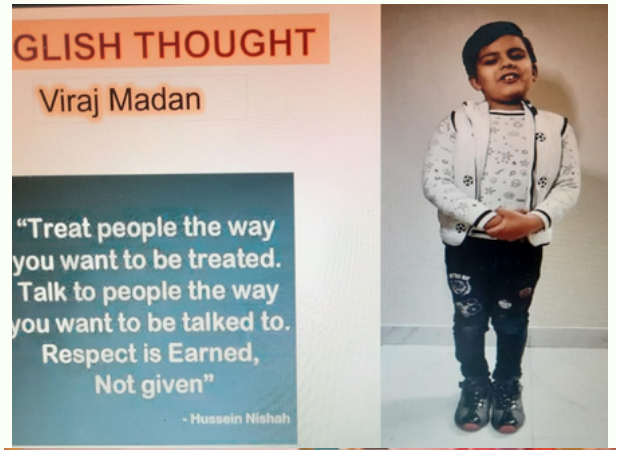

## SP. ASSEMBLY – LITTER LESS LIVE BETTER BY CLASS 1 E

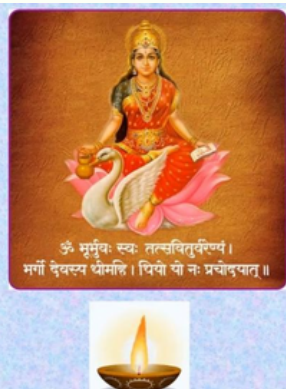
