Our being there and facilitate their learnings is the key here, Let us work on their values and social emotional quotient by being together as family, spend quality time , keep aside your phone and switch off the TV, pick up books (can't encourage reading enough... we have provided links and names of the books,, you can add your choices too) and get your hands dirty in mud, get outside in nature.....endless choices to squeeze in fun time and learnings !

We offer our students the best possible opportunities to become confident, thoughtful young learners who can take ownership of their learning as they grow up future ready, in an exciting and increasingly global world.

We want our young learners to build up the learnings and skills as a treasure. 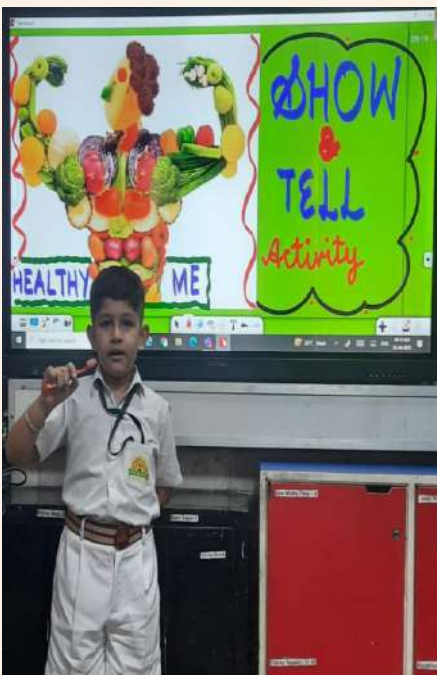


Happiness Starts with Good Health -Health & Hygiene Drive

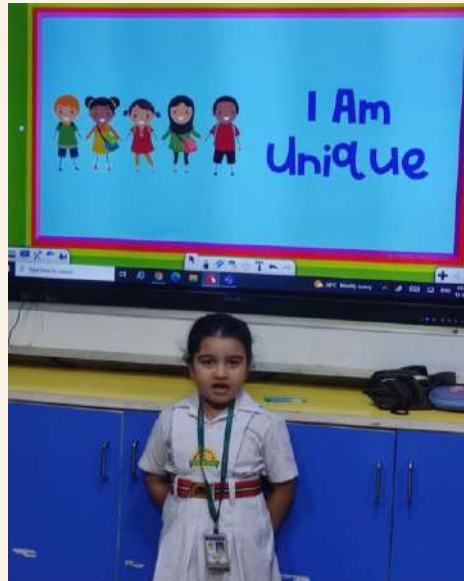


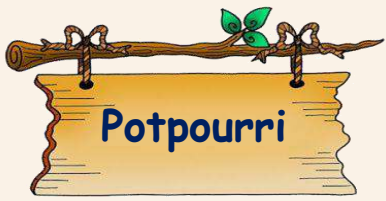
EVS Subject Enrichment Activity
