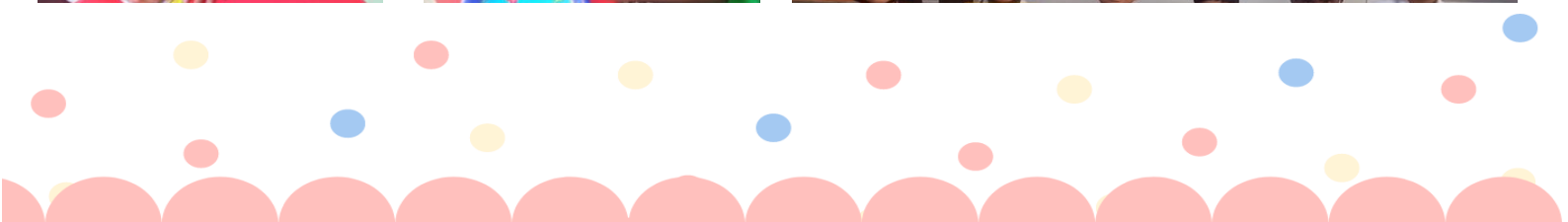


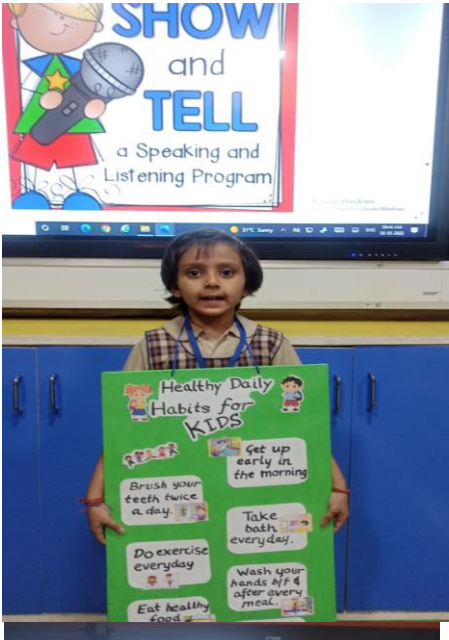

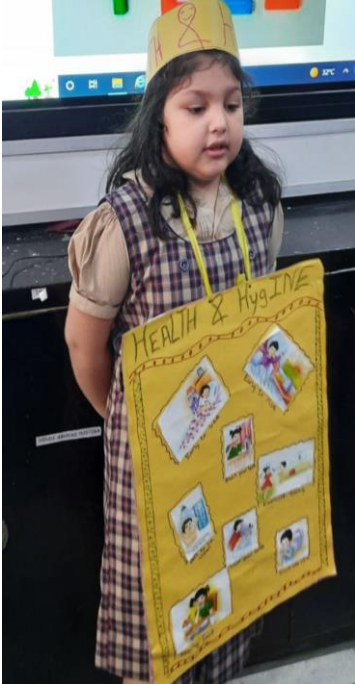
'Let every breath, every word, and every step make the mother earth proud of us'

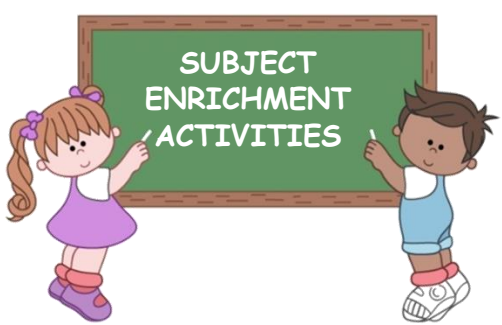


'No language can express the power and beauty and heroism of a mother's love'

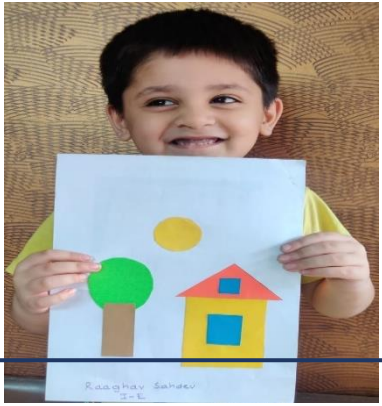
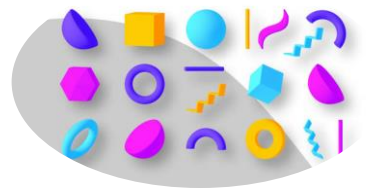

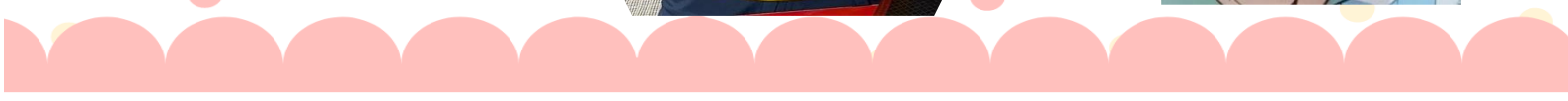


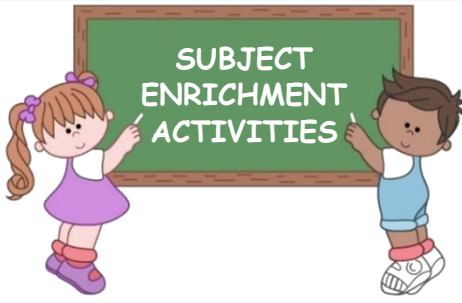


PLAYFUL SHAPES

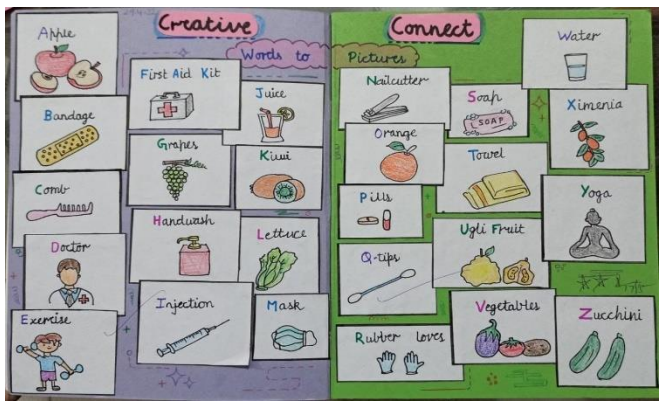

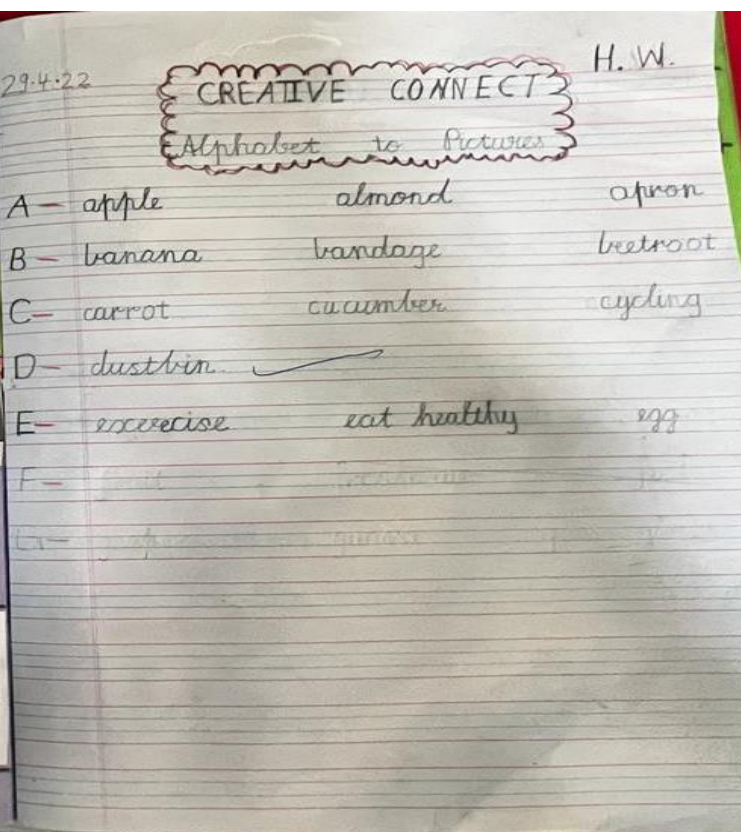
Alphabet to Pictures

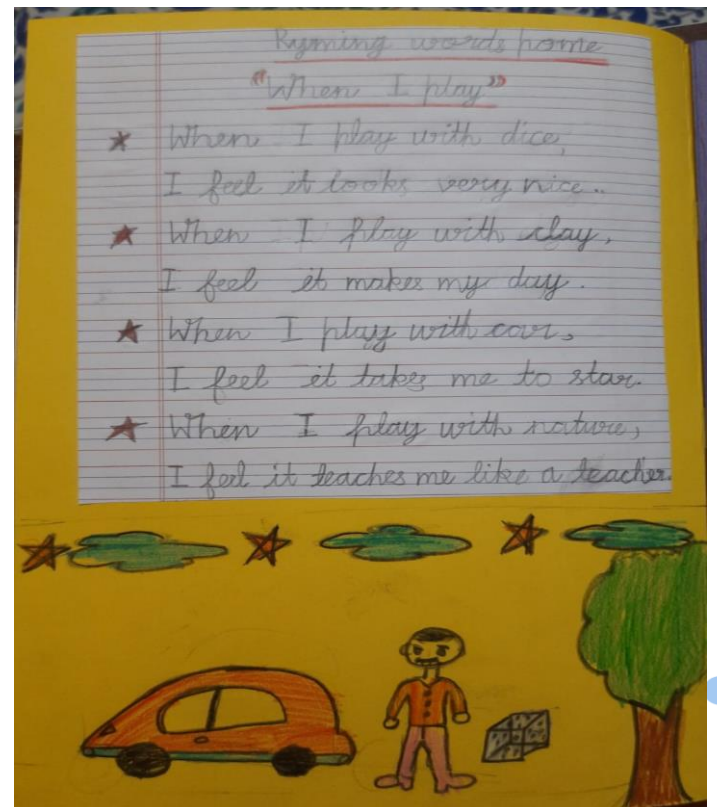
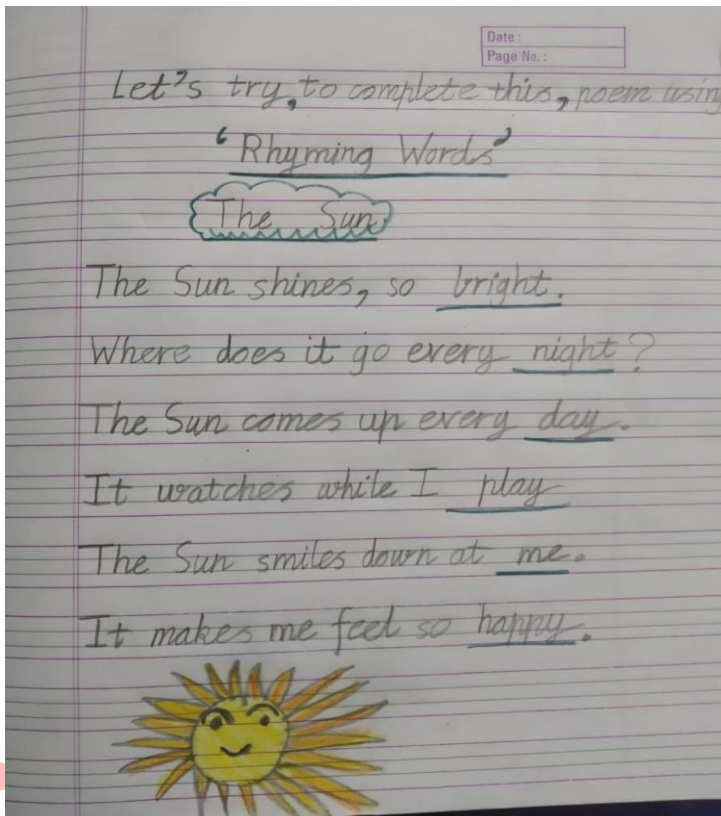
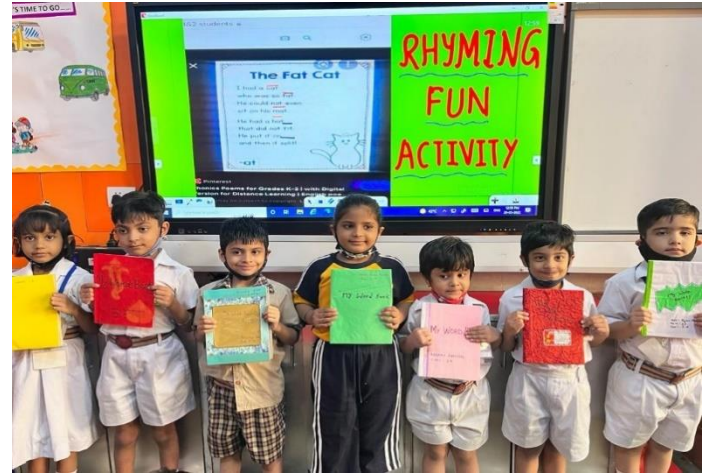
Rhyming Fun

Rhyme Time

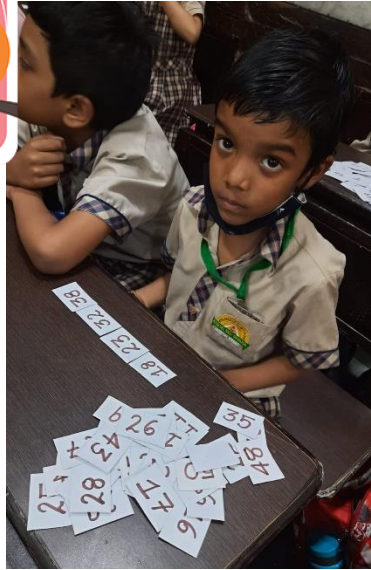
Hearing and using rhyme, rhythm and repetition helps students develop early literacy skills. It enhances their knowledge and vocabulary

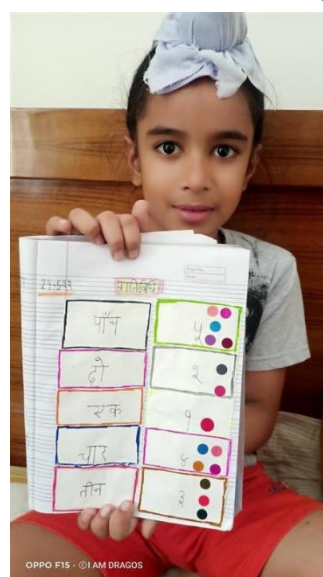
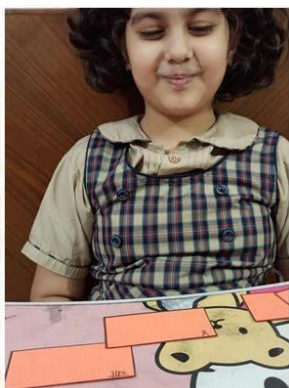
ORDERING OF NUMERS - GO UP AND DOWN THE NUMER CARDS

The students were able to tell the relative position of objects in a sequence using ordinal numbers.



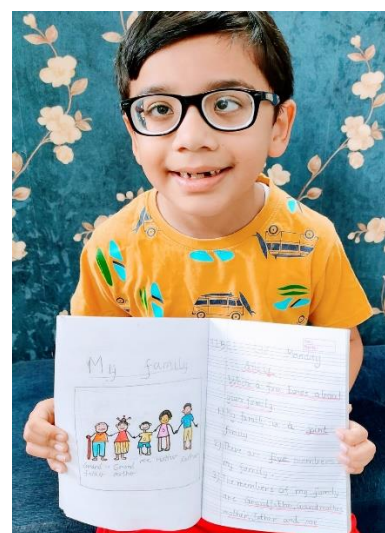
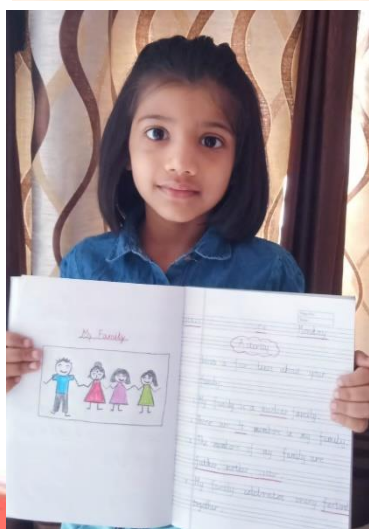

Yoga – Morning Routine

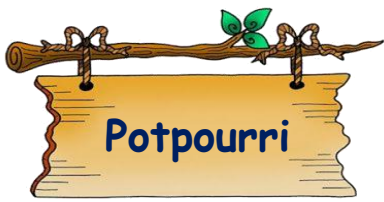

WELCOME DAY

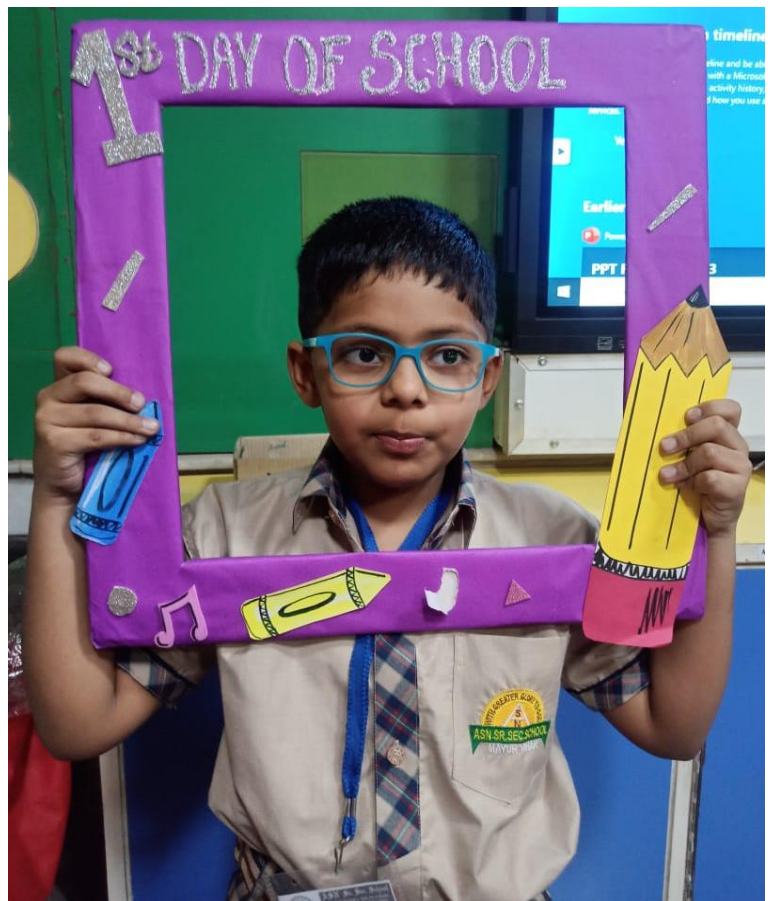
To cheer up our young learners back to school and to create a homely atmosphere, a welcome event was organised by Grade I and II.

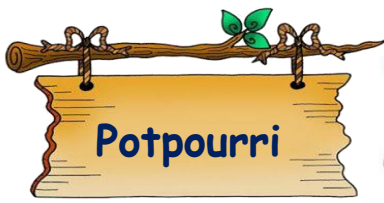
The cheerful welcome day for this academic year started at 8:00 a.m. on 4th April 2022. Teachers affectionately welcome the new comers by holding their hands and escorted them to their classrooms. An unique approach was introduced to welcome the students where, class 1 was allotted specific animal icons in accordance to their initials i.e A - Alligator, B - Butterfly, C - Cheetah, D - Dolphin and E - Elephant. Similarly, all sections of class 2 were allotted special titles i.e A - Amigos, B - Bravehearts, C - Challengers, D - Daredevils and E - Enforcers. The day started off with an Introduction, using a photo frame named First day at School, to engage the students and to build up a strong social skills and bond within them.

Later, story narration using puppets and poem/ rhyme based on the animal icons or class title was delivered in the classroom by the class teachers. To sum up, all the students spent their entire day with great pleasure through interesting and exhilarating activities.

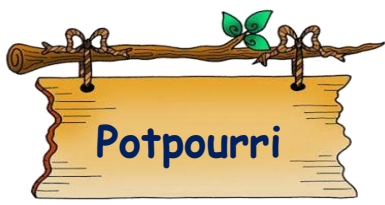




Yoga
