2. Entries submitted without Registration and Declaration form will be disqualified. The last date for the submission of entries is **30th September 2019**.
3. The participant School needs to forward:
 - i. Maximum of two entries of Articles in each English and Hindi separately to be mailed at asnaic@asnschool.org in pdf format.
 - ii. Maximum of two entries of Poems in each English and Hindi separately to be mailed at asnaic@asnschool.org in pdf format.
 - iii. One entry of Movie Making has to be uploaded on YouTube and the link to be shared via email asnaic@asnschool.org
4. In each event, five best entries will be awarded as under:

2. *'खुद को खोजने का सबसे अच्छा तरीका है कि आप खुद को दूसरों की सेवा में खो दें।'*

Guidelines:

- Word Limit: 700 to 800 words
- **Page: A-4 Size with specified font Times New Roman for English & Kruti Dev 011 for Hindi with Font size 14 & 1.5 line spacing**
- Articles should be sent in pdf format.
- All the forwarded entries must have the name of the participant, class & School's name written in bold letters.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

- Poems should be sent in pdf format.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
